Agenda Title: For Possible Action: To make a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors regarding the expenditure of \$750 from the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Redevelopment Revolving Fund to support the 2016 Santa Parade special event as an expense incidental to the carrying out of the Redevelopment Plan that has been adopted by the Carson City Board of Supervisors. (Lee Plemel, lplemel@carson.org)

Staff Summary: Redevelopment annually funds special events from a portion of the Revolving Fund. A total of \$60,000 was budgeted for Special Events in FY 2016-17, and \$33,000 has been allocated leaving \$27,000 available. The requested \$750 would be used for advertising for the Olde Time Santa Parade, an annual event organized by the Downtown 20/20 organization.

Proposed Motion

I move to approve and recommend that the Board of Supervisors authorize the expenditure of \$750 from the Fiscal Year 2016-17 Redevelopment Revolving Fund to support the 2016 Santa Parade as an expense incidental to the carrying out of the Redevelopment Plan that has been adopted by the Carson City Board of Supervisors, and based upon the findings that there is a causal connection between this redevelopment effort and the need for the expenses, the expenses are needed to ensure the success of the redevelopment plan and that the amount of the expenses to be given are minor in comparison to the money required for the overall redevelopment plan.

Board's Strategic Goal

Economic Development

Previous Action

On November 7, 2016, the Redevelopment Authority Citizens Committee (RACC) voted to recommend that the Redevelopment Authority DENY the proposed expenditure by a vote of 6-0. The recommendation to deny was generally based on the belief that the newspaper ad is not a necessary expense to advertise the event, and the event draws few people relative to the proposed expenditure.

Background/Issues & Analysis

The initial round of Special Event applications for FY 2016-17 were reviewed by RACC in May and by the Redevelopment Authority/Board of Supervisors on June 2, 2016. A total of \$60,000 was allocated in the FY 2016-17 budget, but only \$33,000 was allocated to special events leaving \$27,000 available. The Redevelopment Authority Policies and Procedures provide that applications may be submitted on a first-come, first-served basis if funding remains available after the initial round of applications.

The Redevelopment Authority Policies and Procedures identify specific application submittal requirements and establish criteria that the RACC and Redevelopment Authority shall consider when evaluating applications for special event funding. The following factors are identified for consideration:

- a. The number of participants the event draws compared to the amount of Redevelopment funding and other City support requested for the event.
- b. The amount of City funding requested for the event compared to funding obtained or sought from other sources.
- c. The amount of funding requested in past years compared to funding currently being requested.
- d. The longevity of the event in Carson City and its importance to the community.
- e. The possibility for the event to grow in the future.
- f. Potential conflicts with other special events on the same date as the proposed event.
- g. Other factors as deemed appropriate by the Authority.

SPECIAL EVENT APPLICATION:

Following is a summary of the application received with information included that pertains to the review criteria noted above. Refer to the attached application for more detail and explanation.

Applicant: The Downtown 20/20 Group

Event: Olde Time Santa Parade

Requested funding (% of event budget): \$750 (80%, excluding volunteer time and materials)

Description: Downtown Santa parade and related events.

Total event budget: \$934 (excluding volunteer time and materials)

Prior year funding: None

Estimated number of participants (local/out-of-town): 220 (200 / 20)

Dollars of City funding per participant: \$3.40 Number of years event held in Carson City: 9

The requested funding would be used to put an ad in the newspaper to promote the event and draw more people to the event. Note that the event budget includes only expenses and does not account for the volunteer time, materials and services that are provided by a number of people and businesses in support of the event.

The Redevelopment Authority and Board of Supervisors should consider the application review factors noted earlier in this staff report when considering funding for the special event. Any Special Event funding remaining after this allocation may be reallocated at a later date.




