Staff Summary: NRS 361.340 establishes the Carson City Board of Equalization (CCBE) consisting of 5 members. The Mayor shall nominate persons to serve on the CCBE and the nominees must be appointed by a majority vote of the Board of Supervisors. The Mayor shall designate one of the appointees to serve as chair of the CCBE. The Mayor will nominate Jed Block to be appointed to the CCBE, Supervisor Barrette will nominate Roy Semmons, and Supervisor Bonkowski will nominate Carson McFadden. The Mayor will designate Jed Block to serve as chair.

Background/Issues & Analysis

NRS 361.340 (4) The chair of the board of county commissioners shall nominate persons to serve on the county board of equalization who are sufficiently experienced in business generally to be able to bring knowledge and sound judgment to the deliberations of the board or who are elected public officers. The nominees must be appointed upon a majority vote of the board of county commissioners. The chair of the board of county commissioners shall designate one of the appointees to serve as chair of the county board of equalization.

(5) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the term of each member is 4 years and any vacancy must be filled by appointment for the unexpired term. The term of any elected public officer expires upon the expiration of the term of his or her elected office.
