Agenda Title: For Possible Action: To approve an additional purchase of emergency medical equipment and supplies from Life Assist through Joinder Contract with the City of Berkeley #14-10863, in accordance with NRS 332.195, for a not to exceed amount of \$38,000 to be funded from the Ambulance Fund Operating Supplies Account. Staff Summary: For fiscal year 2017, Carson Fire would like to increase the total PO authority by \$38,000 from the current authority of \$82,000 to a total of \$120,000. In fiscal year 2016 Carson Fire spent \$119,625 on medical supplies, with total EMS runs at 8,607. In fiscal 2017 Carson Fire is estimating total spending for medical supplies at \$120,000 with an estimated 9,450 runs . These supplies consist of items such as IV supplies, medications, bandages, splints, and other items used in the treatment of patients.
