This bill revises the boundary line between Carson City and Washoe County.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1.030 of the Carson City Charter, being chapter 213, Statutes of Nevada 1969, as last amended by chapter 246, Statutes of Nevada 1977, at page 446, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1.030 Description of territory. The territory embraced in Carson City is that certain land situate in the State of Nevada, described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of Douglas

- 8 County, Nevada, at a point on the common boundary between the 9 State of Nevada and the State of California; thence due east to the
- 10 shoreline of Lake Tahoe; thence easterly along the south boundaries
- 11 of a portion of section 33, all of 34, 35 and 36, T. 15 N., R. 18 E.,
- 12 M.D.B. & M.; thence continuing easterly along the south boundaries
- 13 of sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36, T. 15 N., R. 19 E., to the
- southwest corner of section 31, T. 15 N., R. 20 E.; thence continuing
- 15 easterly along the south boundary of section 31 to the east 1/16





corner common to section 31 and section 6, T. 14 N., R. 20 E.; 2 thence southerly along the north-south centerline of the NE 1/4 of 3 section 6, a distance of 300 feet, more or less, to the center north-4 north-northeast 1/256 corner of section 6; thence easterly along the 5 east-west centerline NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of section 6 6, a distance of 660 feet, more or less to the center north-northeast-7 northeast 1/256 corner of section 6; thence northerly along the 8 north-south centerline of the NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of section 6, a 9 distance of 300 feet, more or less, to the east-east 1/64 corner 10 common to section 6, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., and section 31, T. 15 N., R. 11 20 E.; thence easterly along the south boundary of section 31 to its 12 southeast corner; thence continuing easterly along the south 13 boundary of section 32, T. 15 N., R. 20 E., to the one-quarter corner 14 common to section 32 and section 5, T. 14 N., R. 20 E.; thence 15 southerly along the north-south one-quarter section line of section 5 16 to the one-quarter corner common to section 5 and section 8, T. 14 17 N., R. 20 E.; thence easterly along the boundary common to sections 18 5 and 8 to the northeast corner of section 8; thence southerly along 19 the boundary common to section 8 and section 9, T. 14 N., R. 20 E., 20 to the southeast corner of section 8; thence easterly along the south 21 boundaries of section 9, 10, 11 and 12, T. 14 N., R. 20 E.; thence 22 continuing easterly along the south boundaries of sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12, T. 14 N., R. 21 E.; thence easterly along the south 23 24 boundary of section 7, T. 14 N., R. 22 E. to a point on the centerline 25 of Eldorado Canyon and from which point the southeast corner of 26 section 7 bears S. 89'51" E. a distance of 1,386 feet; thence down 27 the center of Eldorado Canyon to a point thereon due east of Brown 28 & Company's dam on the Carson River; thence in a westerly 29 direction, crossing the Carson River at the dam; thence to the Half 30 Way House, between Carson and Silver City; thence northwesterly 31 to the summit of the mountains east of Washoe Lake; thence 32 southwesterly to the corner common to sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, 33 T. 16 N., R. 20 E.; thence westerly along the common boundaries between sections 15 and 22 and between 16 and 21, T. 16 N., R. 20 34 35 E. to the corner common to sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, T. 16 N., R. 36 20 E.; thence southerly along the common boundary between 37 sections 20 and 21 to the corner common to sections 20, 21, 28 and 38 29, T. 16 N., R. 20 E.; thence westerly along the common boundary 39 between sections 20 and 29 to the corner common to sections 19, 20, 29 and 30, T. 16 N., R. 20 E.; thence southerly along the 40 common boundary between sections 29 and 30 to the corner 41 common to sections 29, 30, 31 and 32, T. 16 N., R. 20 E.; thence 42 westerly along the common boundary between sections 30 and 31, 43 44 T. 16 N., R. 20 E. and sections 25 and 36, T. 16 N., R. 19 E., to the 45 1/4 corner common to sections 25 and 36, thence southerly along





the north-south 1/4 section line of section 36 to the center of section 2 36; 1/4 corner common to sections 29 and 30, T. 16 N., R. 20 E.; 3 thence westerly along the east-west quarter section line to the quarter corner common to section 25, T. 16 N., R. 19 E. and 4 5 section 30, T. 16 N., R. 20 E; thence westerly along the east-west quarter section line to the east quarter corner of section 25, T. 16 N., R. 19 E.; thence the following four courses as shown on Land Map No. 142, filed in the Official Records of Washoe County, File 8 No. 1666105, April 21, 1993: (1) N. 89°29'09" W., a distance of 9 1,321.54 feet; (2) thence S. 01°14'01" W., a distance of 1,327.16 10 feet; (3) thence N. 89°27'57" W., a distance of 1,318.14 feet; (4) 11 thence S. 01°00'09" W., a distance of 1,327.93 feet, to a found 12 13 stone scribed "1/4" being the quarter corner common to sections 25 and 36; thence westerly along the common boundary between 14 15 sections 25 and 36, T. 16 N., R. 19 E. to the intersection of the 16 southeasterly right-of-way line of Eastlake Boulevard as shown in 17 the Resolution Relinquishing Portion of Highway Right-of-Way under Document 858920 in the Recorder's Office of Washoe 18 19 County; thence following the said southeasterly right-of-way as 20 shown in said document to the intersection with the easterly right-21 of-way line of U.S. Highway 395; thence southerly along said 22 right-of-way line to the intersection of the east-west 1/4 section line of section 36, T. 16 N., R. 19 E.; thence westerly along the 23 24 east-west 1/4 section line of section 36, T. 16 N., R. 19 E. to a point 25 on that line which lies 839.13 feet easterly from the 1/4 corner common to sections 35 and 36, T. 16 N., R. 19 E.; thence north 26 27 55°26'00" east, 152.32 feet; to the southerly right-of-way line of 28 U.S. Highway 395; thence on a curve to the right from a tangent 29 bearing of north 44°19′39" west, through an angle of 6°15′39" with 30 a radius of 1972 feet, for a length of 215.48 feet; thence north 31 71°36′35″ west, 859.24 feet to the section line common to sections 35 and 36; thence south 86°33′55" west, 2612.76 feet; to the 1/4 32 section line of section 35; thence south 1°39'33" west, 324.06 feet; 33 34 to the center of section 35; thence westerly along the east-west 1/4 section line of sections 34 and 35, T. 16 N., R. 19 E. to the 1/4 35 corner common to sections 34 and 35, T. 16 N., R. 19 E.; thence 36 southerly along the common boundary between sections 34 and 35 37 38 to the southeast corner of section 34; thence westerly along the common boundary between section 34, T. 16 N., R. 19 E., and 39 section 3, T. 15 N., R. 19 E., to the northwest corner of section 3; 40 41 thence southerly along the common boundary between sections 3 and 4, T. 15 N., R. 19 E., to the 1/4 corner common to sections 3 42 and 4; thence westerly along the east-west 1/4 section line of section 43 44 4 to the center of section 4; thence southerly along the north-south 45 1/4 section line of section 4 to the 1/4 corner common to sections 4





and 9, T. 15 N., R. 19 E.; thence westerly along the common 2 boundary between sections 4 and 9 to the corner common to sections 4, 5, 8 and 9, T. 15 N., R. 19 E.; thence southerly along the common boundary between sections 8 and 9 to the corner common 5 to sections 8, 9, 16 and 17, T. 15 N., R. 19 E.; thence westerly along the common boundary between sections 8 and 17 to the corner common to sections 7, 8, 17 and 18, T. 15 N., R. 19 E.; thence 7 8 southerly along the common boundary between sections 17 and 18 9 to the north 1/64th corner common to sections 17 and 18, T. 15 N., 10 R. 19 E.; thence westerly along the north boundary of the S 1/2 S 1/2 N 1/2 of section 18 to the north 1/64th corner common to 11 12 sections 18, T. 15 N., R. 19 E. and 13, T. 15 N., R. 18 E.; thence 13 continuing westerly along the north boundary of the S 1/2 S 1/2 N 14 1/2 of sections 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and a portion of 18, T. 15 N., R. 18 15 E., to the Nevada-California state line; thence south along the 16 California line to the place of beginning. 17

Sec. 2. 1. All taxes and pledged revenue in existence before July 1, 2017, must not be directly or indirectly modified in such a manner as to impair adversely any outstanding obligations of Carson City until all those obligations have been discharged in full or provision for their payment and redemption has been fully made.

2. All taxes and pledged revenue in existence before July 1, 2017, must not be directly or indirectly modified in such a manner as to impair adversely any outstanding obligations of Washoe County until all those obligations have been discharged in full or provision for their payment and redemption has been fully made.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2017.
