Staff Summary: The purchase of this Basic Life Service (BLS) ambulance and the new BLS service will increase the ability of the Fire Department to better service the citizens of Carson City. This BLS ambulance will be staffed by Basic Emergency Medical Technicians. They will respond to BLS type calls which will allow our Advanced Life Support (ALS) Paramedics to respond to calls for service that need a higher level of care. This BLS ambulance will operate on a 40 hour a week schedule in order to divert medical calls away from Advanced Life Support units.

Background/Issues & Analysis

Emergency Calls for service to the Carson City Fire Department (CCFD) have more than doubled since 1999, (4,795 calls in 1999, to 10,500 calls for service in 2016). Of these calls, 90% were for emergency medical services. Over this same time period, the number of fire engines and ambulances has not grown. At the current pace for 2017; at an average of 27.6 calls per day, CCFD will run over 11,000 calls this year. This increase in calls without an accompanying increase in response resources has placed a greater importance on current mutual aid agreements with neighboring counties. In some instances, all resources are completely depleted and emergency calls are prioritized and callers for emergency medical services are asked to wait. CCFD request mutual aid resources over 300 times per year. A major concern at this point, is the lack of resources to handle the workload.


