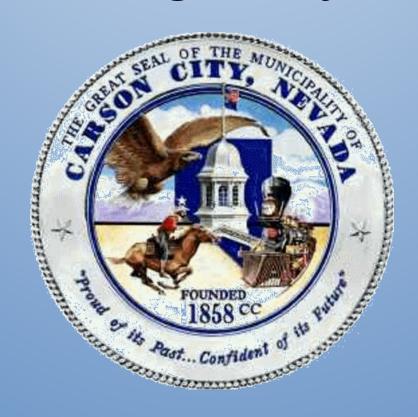

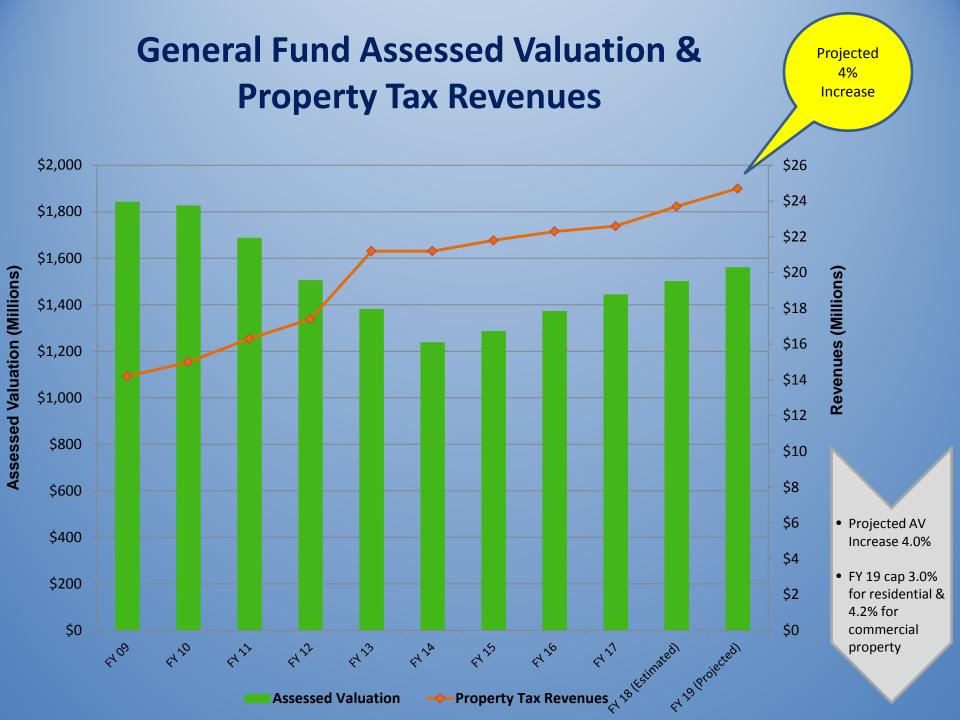

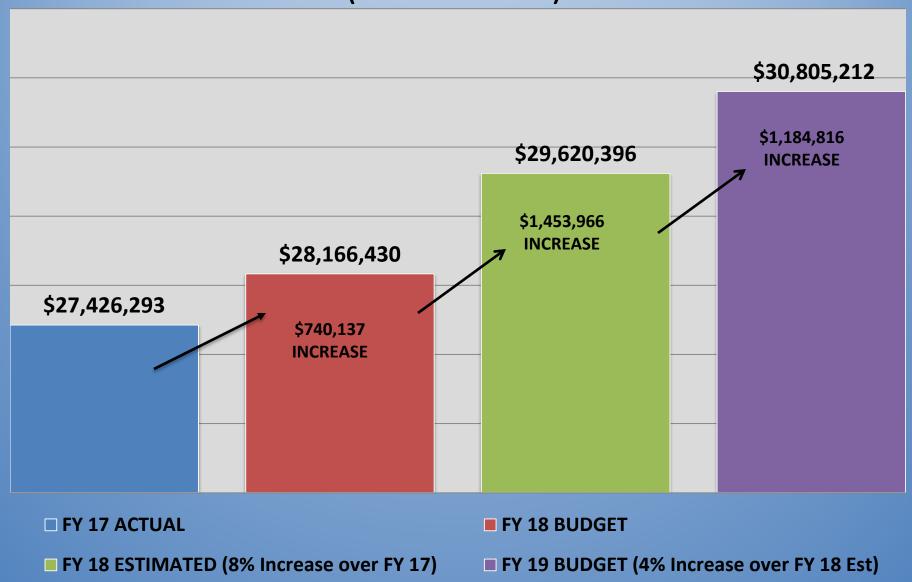


General Fund Projected Property Tax Revenue
