**Agenda Title:** For Possible Action: To appoint three members to the Advisory Board to Manage Wildlife to represent the "Sportsman, Rancher, or Farmer" positions each for a three year term that will expire July 2021.

**Staff Summary:** NRS 501.260 and 501.265 provide for a three or five member county advisory board to manage wildlife, with qualified persons appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The Carson City Board to Manage Wildlife is comprised of five members and there are three positions open due to expiring terms. The members to be appointed must be residents of Carson City and must also be hunters, trappers or anglers (sportsman position), or engaged in ranching (rancher position) or farming in Carson City (farmer position). An application for reappointment was received from Gilbert Yanuck and Robert Boehmer. Applications for new appointments were received from Myles Burdett, Tyler Creel, Mark Crowder, Michael Evans, Adam Hulme and Daniel Thompson.



## Gilbert A. Yanuck

Prior to his retirement in February 1999, Mr. Yanuck was President and Chief Executive Officer of MAG Aerospace Industries, Inc. Mr. Yanuck was responsible for overall performance of MAG and *Monogram Systems*, its principal operating division and the world's largest supplier of aircraft sanitation and on-board water management systems, crew seats, air-stairs and galley chillers. Mr. Yanuck spent 28 years with MAG and was President from 1989 to 1999. His responsibilities included the financial performance, strategic and operational planning as well as the resource development and allocation for the Company.

As President, Mr. Yanuck has led the dynamic growth of the Company into new technological areas of sanitation systems for aircraft and surface transportation applications. He was responsible for MAG becoming the first company to be given total system responsibility for a major aircraft sub-system by Airbus. Mr. Yanuck also was instrumental in establishing a firm base of operation in Taiwan and China, which quickly became major customers for the Company's products. Mr. Yanuck was responsible for the acquisition of Aero-Design Technology, Inc. (ATI), which has enabled the Company to enjoy the synergy of two dynamic and complimentary waste management products.

Mr. Yanuck received a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Alabama and a Masters Degree in Business Administration from California State University. He has accumulated extensive management experience in a wide variety of business and market conditions.

Prior to joining MAG, Mr. Yanuck was General Manager of the Engineering and Record Manufacturing Divisions of Keysor Century Corporation. He was responsible for the construction of an automated PVC-blending facility and the conversion from manual to automated record production. This enabled the company to maintain its position as the largest supplier of custom-blended PVC on the West Coast and to maintain their supply contracts with Columbia Records and the U.S. Government. Prior to joining Keysor Century Corporation, Mr. Yanuck held various supervisory and engineering positions with Controls Division of Leach Corporation and the Aeronutronic and Transmission and Chassis Divisions of Ford Motor Company. Mr. Yanuck also served as a director of Argo-Tech Corporation, the largest supplier of jet engine fuel pumps for commercial and military aircraft, Astromec, Inc. a leading manufacturer of precision miniature motors and Worldwide Flight Services, Inc., the leading provider of passenger, ramp and cargo services to the commercial aviation industry.

Mr. Yanuck was born in Brooklyn, New York and lived in Southern California for 36 years. Mr. Yanuck relocated to Carson City, Nevada in February 1999 where

he continues to be active as a consultant to various businesses in the United States and Europe and volunteers his time to a number of community and civic organizations. Mr. Yanuck was Chairman of the Carson City Advisory Board to Manage Wildlife, a member of the Governor's Conservation Team, a member of the Carson-Tahoe Hospital Membership Board, Chairman of the Carson Tahoe Board of Trustees, Member of the Carson Tahoe Board of Directors, and a member of the Carson Tahoe Investment and Financing Committee. Mr. Yanuck was the Senior District Coordinator for the AARP's Tax-Aide program in Northern Nevada and serves as the AARP Ambassador to Carson City. Mr. Yanuck served as a Director and Chairman of the Carson City Chamber of Commerce in Carson City, Nevada. In 2004, Mr. Yanuck was appointed by the Secretary of the Treasury to represent the State of Nevada on the National Taxpayer Advocacy Panel. In 2009, Mr. Yanuck was selected by AARP to receive its Andrus Award, the association's most prestigious and visible award for community service. Mr. Yanuck continues to operate an active management consulting business specializing in mergers and acquisitions.



#### NRS 501.260 Creation; number of members; officers.

- 1. There is hereby created a county advisory board to manage wildlife in each of the several counties.
  - 2. In a county whose population:
- (a) Is less than 700,000, each board consists of three or five members, at the discretion of the board of county commissioners.
- (b) Is 700,000 or more, each board consists of five or seven members, at the discretion of the board of county commissioners.
  - 3. A chair and vice chair must be selected by each board.

## NRS 501.265 Appointment of members; vacancies.

- 1. The board of county commissioners shall appoint qualified persons to the board who are residents of the county and are:
  - (a) Hunters, trappers or anglers; or
  - (b) Engaged in ranching or farming in the county.
- 2. In addition to the members appointed pursuant to subsection 1, the board of county commissioners shall appoint one qualified person to the board who represents the interests of the general public of the county. The person appointed pursuant to this subsection must be a resident of the county from which he or she is appointed.
- 3. Within 60 days after a vacancy occurs, the board of county commissioners shall, if the vacant member was appointed:
  - (a) Pursuant to subsection 1, appoint a member to the board upon the recommendation of:
    - (1) Organizations that represent hunters, trappers or anglers in the county; and
    - (2) Persons who are engaged in ranching or farming in the county.
- (b) Pursuant to subsection 2, appoint a member to the board pursuant to the provisions of that subsection.
- 4. Within 90 days after a vacancy occurs, the board of county commissioners shall report to the Commission the name and address of each member appointed.

**NRS 501.293 Removal of member.** Members of boards may be removed by the boards of county commissioners of the counties served for cause, including, but not limited to, absences from three consecutive, duly called board meetings, unless excused by their respective board chairs.

**NRS 501.297 Duties: Evaluating local opinion and advising Commission.** The boards shall solicit and evaluate local opinion and advise the Commission on matters relating to the management of wildlife.

# NRS 501.303 Duties: Submission of recommendations; attendance of chair or other members at meetings of Commission.

- 1. The boards shall submit recommendations for the management of wildlife and setting seasons for fishing, hunting and trapping, which must be considered by the Commission in its deliberation on and establishment of regulations.
  - 2. The chair or vice chair, or members of the board appointed by them:
  - (a) Shall attend the meetings of the Commission; and
  - (b) Are entitled to receive such travel and per diem expenses as are allowed by law. (Added to NRS by 1969, 1560; A 1979, 893; 1985, 1351; 1989, 2192; 2015, 958)
