


# Legislative Activities

- City Staff will be working with our Federal Lobbyists, Porter Group, and Senator Cortez Masto's Office to develop language for inclusion in the Senate version of the Nevada Technical Corrections Bill.
  - This is to correct those lands that were transferred to Carson City through the Lands Bill that may
    be more appropriate for economic development and others that are deemed for public purposes
    but are a maintenance burden for the City. The Parks, Recreation & Open Space Department and

    process.





A Zoning Map Amendment to change the zoning from Single-Family one Acre to Retail Commercial for the western portion of the subject properties.






