100% of all residential referrals from Carson City were placed in Vitality System as requested by referral between April-September 2018

Civil Protective Custody (CPC) referrals are closely monitored with Carson City Sheriff's Office for compliance

Program Overview

- 1. Vitality Unlimited Medical Director is Dr. Chris Highley in Carson City, NV.
- 2. Vitality Unlimited Carson City is state certified for the following treatment levels based upon ASAM treatment guidelines:

Civil Protective Custody (CPC)- a person cannot be held for more than 48 hours

Level I outpatient services- an average of 6 hours of treatment a week

Level 2.1 Intensive Outpatient Care- an average of 9 hours of treatment a week

Level 3.5 residential Services- an average of 60 days

Level I and level 2.1 Withdrawal Management (detox)- an average of 24-72 hours

- 3. Carson City is licensed for 25 beds
- 4. Vitality screens with consent and in compliance with state and federal HIPAA regulations for TB and HIV/AIDS for clients entering the residential program. Results are communicated to the State Compliance Coordinator.
