

# QI PROJECT SURVEYS OF CCHHS TOURS 2018 VS 2019

# 2018 - 289 Freshman were surveyed

- 10% in 2018 felt they would be uncomfortable in the lobby
- 21 out of 289 Students in 2018 stated the Building was not "teen friendly"
- 70% in 2018 answered yes "we had services they didn't know existed"

# 2019 - 252 Freshman were surveyed


- 8% said they felt uncomfortable in the lobby
- ONLY 2 Freshman Stated that CCHHS was NOT "teen friendly"
- 64% answered YES to "we had services they didn't know existed
- OVERALL Negative responses to questions about Comfort and Knowledge were under 14%.


