Agenda Title: For Possible Action: Discussion and possible action to introduce, on first reading, an

ordinance relating to recording fees and amending Title 2 of the Carson City Municipal Code (CCMC) to impose an additional \$6.00 fee on recording certain documents with the Carson City Clerk-Recorder's office with the proceeds, estimated to be \$47,000 or more in fiscal year (FY) 2020, supporting legal services for abused or neglected children. Staff Summary: This is the first reading of a proposed ordinance amending Title 2 of the CCMC to add Chapter 2.45, which will implement a \$6.00 fee increase on recording certain documents with the Carson City Clerk-Recorder's office. The \$6.00 fee was authorized by the Nevada Legislature in 2017 and the proceeds will be to support legal services for

abused and neglected children.

#### Background/Issues & Analysis

In 2011, the Nevada Legislature adopted an amendment to NRS 247.305 to allow counties to impose a fee of not more than \$3.00 for recording certain documents with the county recorder. The proceeds from this fee are required to be used to support organizations providing legal services to the indigent to fund legal services for abused and neglected children. During the 2017 session, the Legislature adopted Senate Bill 305 that increased the optional fee to \$6.00. Carson City has not previously imposed the optional fee allowed by NRS 247.305(4). On October 5, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Contract No. 1718-090, in the amount of \$105,000 with Washoe Legal Services to provide legal services to indigent abused and neglected children in Carson City. The current contract ends June 30, 2020. Amending the Clerk-Recorder fees will generate an estimated \$47,000 or more in FY 2020, which will assist in off-setting costs for the appointment of attorneys in these cases. The new fee would become effective January 1, 2020.

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE CARSON CITY CLERK-RECORDER; AMENDING TITLE 2 (ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL) OF THE CARSON CITY MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADD A NEW CHAPTER 2.45 (FEES ON DOCUMENT RECORDING TO SUPPORT LEGAL SERVICES FOR ABUSED OR NEGLECTED CHILDREN) TO ESTABLISH AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR THE RECORDING OF CERTAIN DOCUMENTS BY THE CARSON CITY CLERK-RECORDER; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

The Board of Supervisors of Carson City do ordain:

#### SECTION I:

That Title 2 (ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL) is hereby amended by adding thereto a new chapter (**bold, underlined** text is added, [stricken] text is deleted) as follows:

# <u>Chapter 2.45 – FEES ON DOCUMENT RECORDING TO SUPPORT LEGAL SERVICES FOR ABUSED AND NEGLECTED CHILDREN.</u>

#### SECTION II:

That Title 2 (ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL), new Chapter 2.45 (FEES ON DOCUMENT RECORDING TO SUPPORT LEGAL SERVICES FOR ABUSED AND NEGLECTED CHILDREN) is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section (**bold**, **underlined** text is added, [stricken] text is deleted) as follows:

### CCMC 2.45.010 – Document recording fee.

- 1. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 247.305, the Carson City Clerk-Recorder shall, in addition to any other fee the Clerk-Recorder is authorized to charge and collect pursuant to NRS, charge and collect a fee of \$6 for recording a document, instrument, paper, notice, deed, conveyance, map, chart, survey or any other writing.
- 2. The amount of fees collected pursuant to subsection 1 must be:

<del></del>	Paid and remitted in the manner required by NRS 247.305; and
<u>(b)</u>	Used to provide legal services for abused and neglected children in accordance with
NR	S 247.305.
