Background/Issues & Analysis

Carson City has recently determined that a formal offer or dedication and acceptance of Richmond Avenue have never occurred. The City has historically maintained Richmond Avenue as part of the current road system. The area of the dedication lies within the Carson City School District parcel, known as Carson Middle School, APN 003-171-01. The area of Richmond Avenue has been mapped on Carson City Assessor's Pages as being a City owned roadway, and not shown as part of any parcel. City staff and consultant efforts have been unable to find any documentation to support the current mapping. The City is seeking to complete this formal dedication from the Carson City School District for the area known as Richmond Avenue. The dedication of this road will split the Carson Middle School parcel, creating two small remnant parcels on the east side of the dedication. One of these two remnant parcels is currently used for Carson Middle School staff parking. The other contains landscaping related improvements by the adjacent homeowners. The Carson City School District would retain ownership of the two parcels lying east of the dedication. Final acceptance of any offer of dedication is subject to the approval of the Carson City Board of Supervisors.


