middle school attendance zones in the Carson City School District, primarily affecting families residing in the Fremont Elementary School attendance zone, beginning with the fall semester of the 2020-2021 school year. (Richard Stokes, rstokes@carson.k12.nv.us)

Staff Summary: As part of the plan to manage current and projected student enrollment growth, modifications to the District's Middle School attendance zones are being proposed. For the 2020-2021 school year, it is proposed that the Eagle Valley Middle School (EVMS) attendance zone be modified to accept all 5th grade students who are promoting from or residing in the Fremont Elementary attendance zone. Currently, approximately one-quarter or about 25 of the promoting 5th graders at Fremont Elementary School are zoned to attend EVMS and the remaining three-quarters or about 75 students are zoned to attend Carson Middle School. This proposal is an early effort to help reduce some of the over-crowding at Carson Middle School for the 2020-2021 school year. District staff will work closely with the schools, staff (if any), and patrons involved in this proposed change.
