Report: Initiating a Housing Authority

- City staff met with Bill Brewer and staff at Nevada Rural Housing Authority (NRHA)
- Information Gathered
 - No additional funding to Carson City
 - Would be competing with NRHA for funding
 - Costly to Carson City Staffing for added responsibilities
 - Managing a Housing Choice voucher waitlist
 - 1700 households on waitlist 16% from Carson City
 - 287 residents of Carson City currently on a Housing Choice voucher
 - Conduct inspections
 - No additional authority over motel/hotel compliance
 - Will not result in more affordable housing
- Recommendation Carson City continues to partner with NRHA and not create another housing authority

Proposal #1 – Health to Home

- Population Individuals being discharged from the hospital with limited funds
- Need No federal or state funding for group housing
- Proposal
 - O Partner with Spirit of Hope, a local non-profit agency, to house these individuals
 - Group housing model for safety and oversight
 - Temporary housing option until individual can return to independent living
 - Housing exclusively for CCHHS referred individuals
 - Life skill training available
 - Community Health Worker available to assist as needed

Proposal #1 – Health to Home, Cont.

- Budget approximately \$3,000/month (1 house)
- Goal Providing a safe environment for individuals at risk for re-hospitalization; transitioning individuals to independent living

Proposal #2 – Home for Seniors

- Population Seniors on fixed incomes at risk of being priced out of their home
- Need No federal or state funding [rents over Fair Market Rents (FMR), no funding for mobile home space rent]
- Proposal
 - Assist seniors with meeting basic shelter needs
 - CCHHS Case Managers available to assist with connecting to available resources to eliminate debt
 - Community Health Worker available to assist as needed
 - Reduce isolation for seniors with little to no interactions
 - Referrals from Senior Center and CCHHS

Proposal #2 – Home for Seniors

- Budget To be discussed
- Goal
 - Preventing homelessness
 - Keeping seniors in their home
 - Lessening financial burden by lessening/eliminating debt
