Water service increase: 3% twice in 2021, and once each year 2022, 2023, & 2024 is a huge increase.

Waste water service increase: 3.5% twice in 2021, once each year in 2022, 2023 & 2024.

Storm water had no % listed, but lists increases in 2021, 2022, 2023, & 2024.

These increases are greater than CPI. I have seen my water bill go from winter use ~\$10, & summer use ~\$70 (1990's). I'm not sure when current rates went into effect, but my bill is \$85 to \$110(summer). I certainly don't use much water in winter!

The proposed increases seem excessive!

Help for Utilities Assistance program is admirable, but what percent of Carson City needs assistance ?

Expansion of Waste Water Treatment Plant was funded in part by Federal funds.

New housing construction & commercial buildings need to be assessed at higher rates as those of us who have lived here years have paid for infrastructure already in place.
