**Agenda Title:** For Possible Action: Discussion and possible action regarding the appointment of three members to the Carson City Board of Equalization ("CCBOE"), each to fill a four-year term ending in January, 2025. (Kimberly Adams, kadams@carson.org)

Staff Summary: NRS 361.340 establishes the CCBOE, consisting of 5 members. The Mayor shall nominate persons to serve on the CCBOE and the nominees must be appointed by a majority vote of the Board of Supervisors. The Mayor shall designate one of the appointees to serve as chair of the CCBOE. The Mayor is nominating Jed Block to be appointed to the CCBOE. Newly elected Supervisor Schuette is recommending that the Mayor nominate James Wells. Newly elected Supervisor White is recommending that the Mayor nominate Pamela Leonard Ray. The Mayor will designate Jed Block to serve as chair.

I move to appoint Jed Block, James Wells and Pamela Leonard Ray to the Carson City Board of Equalization, each to fill a term expiring in January, 2025, and to designate Jed Block as chair.

### **Background/Issues & Analysis**

Pursuant to NRS 361.340(4), the chair of the board of county commissioners (or, as applied to Carson City, its Mayor for the Board of Supervisors) shall nominate persons to serve on the county board of equalization who are sufficiently experienced in business generally to be able to bring knowledge and sound judgment to the deliberations of the board or who are elected public officers. The nominees must be appointed upon a majority vote of the board of county commissioners. The Mayor shall designate one of the appointees to serve as chair of the county board of equalization. Pursuant to NRS 361.340(5), the term of each member is 4 years and any vacancy must be filled by appointment for the unexpired term. The term of any elected public officer expires upon the expiration of the term of his or her elected office.
