Agenda Title: For Possible Action: Discussion and possible action regarding a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors for the expenditure of \$121,573 from the Fiscal Year ("FY") 2021 Redevelopment Revolving Fund for downtown holiday decorations in the amount of \$95,000, bike racks for businesses in the amount of \$5,000, V&T arch conceptual plans in the amount of \$20,000 and historic V&T bike and pedestrian trail markers in the amount of \$1,573. Staff Summary: NRS 279.628 permits the expenditure of money from the Redevelopment Revolving Fund for the purpose of any expenses necessary or incidental to the carrying out of redevelopment plans by a majority vote of the Redevelopment Authority and the adoption of a resolution by a two-thirds majority vote of the Board of Supervisors. The proposed expenditures were recommended for approval by the Redevelopment Authority Citizens Committee on February 1, 2021.
