ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Administrative Order filed on April 15, 2020 is hereby modified.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED effective June 1, 2021, for the protection of the employees and juveniles committed at the Juvenile Detention Center, persons who can show verified proof of COVID-19 vaccination will be permitted to enter the facility for visitation and/or other related matters therein. To minimize the risk of COVID-19 and variant spread, persons must follow the established safety guidelines as directed by the detention employees.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the number of public permitted into the Juvenile Detention Center will be reduced to allow for 3ft. social distancing. Masks or facial coverings will be required to be worn at all times.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other provisions of the Administrative Order filed on March 17, 2020, will continue in full force and effect or until modified or rescinded by a subsequent order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the First Judicial District Court Clerk's Office disseminate copies of the order to the Carson City Manager, Carson City District Attorney,
