2	A RESOLUTION CREATING THE ARTS AND CULTURE FUND,		
3	A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND		
4	WHEREAS, NRS 354.612 provides that the Carson City Board of Supervisors may		
5	establish a special revenue fund by resolution which describes the purpose of the fund, the		
6	resources to be used to establish the fund, the sources to be used to replenish the fund, the method		
7	for controlling the expenses and revenues of the fund, and the method by which a determination		
8	will be made as to whether the balance of the fund is reasonable and necessary to carry out the		
9	purpose of the fund.		
10	NOW, THEREFORE, the Carson City Board of Supervisors does hereby resolve:		
11	1) The purpose of the fund is to account for the 1% transient lodging tax dedicated to		
12	funding the employment and administration of the Arts and Culture Coordinator, the associated		
13	costs in diversifying cultural offerings that allow Carson City to compete in the cultural tourism		
14	market, and all operational costs associated with the implementation of the Carson City Arts and		
15	Culture Master Plan; and		
16	2) The resources used to establish and replenish the fund is the 1% transient lodging tax		
17	remitted to Carson City by the Carson City Culture and Tourism Authority; and		
18	3) The method for controlling expenses and revenues of the fund is the budgeting and		
19	financial accounting policies administered by the City Finance Department. The fund will be		
20	exempt from annual City cost allocation plan charges. Any General Fund administrative costs		
21	associated with the fund will be covered pursuant to the 1st Amended Cooperative Agreement		
22	between the City and the Carson City Culture and Tourism Authority for administrative services;		
23	and		
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2	4) The Arts and Culture Coordinator will make an annual determination as to whether the		
3	balance, reserve, or retained earnings of the fund are reasonable and necessary to carry out the		
4	purpose of the fund.
