#### Background/Issues & Analysis

The Assessor's Office is requesting approval to remove \$863.94 from the 2021/2022 Real Property Tax Roll from APN 009-102-19 per NRS 361.765. The owner, a 100% Disabled Veteran, requested that \$24,200 of his \$29,200 assessed valuation exemption be deducted from his 2021/2022 real property taxes. Due to a clerical error, the exemption was not applied. The exemption is calculated by multiplying the tax rate of 3.5700 by the assessed valuation of \$24,200 which equates to an amount of \$863.94.
