Agenda Title: For Possible Action: Discussion and possible action regarding a proposed resolution authorizing the expenditure of \$435,000 from the fiscal year ("FY") 2022 Redevelopment Revolving Fund Undesignated Projects for additional sidewalks and pedestrian ramp improvements in the redevelopment areas, as an expense incidental to the carrying out of the Redevelopment Plan. Pursuant to NRS 279.628, in order to be adopted, this Resolution requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the Board of Supervisors.

Staff Summary: NRS 279.628 permits the expenditure of money from the Redevelopment Revolving Fund for the purpose of any expenses necessary or incidental to the carrying out of Redevelopment Plans by the adoption of a resolution by a two-thirds majority vote of the Board of Supervisors upon recommendation by the Redevelopment Authority. At its meeting of May 20, 2021, the Redevelopment Authority requested that Public Works staff identify additional sidewalk and handicap accessibility needs in the Redevelopment Areas. This agenda item is in response to that request.

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R-____

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$435,000 FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2022 REDEVELOPMENT REVOLVING FUND FOR SIDEWALK AND HANDICAP ACCESSIBILITY IMPROVEMENTS AS AN EXPENDITURE INCIDENTAL TO THE CARRYING OUT OF THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN.

WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 279.628, the Carson City Board of Supervisors must approve by resolution, adopted by a two-thirds vote, the expenditure of money from the Revolving Fund for the Redevelopment Authority for any expenses incidental to the carrying out of a Redevelopment Plan adopted by the Carson City Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Plan for Redevelopment Project Area No. 1 encourages redevelopment assistance to repair the street, highway, bicycle and pedestrian circulation system to assure safe, convenient, and aesthetically pleasing access to and throughout the area; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Plan for Redevelopment Project Area No. 2 encourages redevelopment assistance to improve traffic circulation throughout the Project Area; and

WHEREAS, this incidental expense is necessary to ensure the Redevelopment Plan's objectives have been met.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Carson City Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the expenditure of \$435,000 from the Fiscal Year 2022 Redevelopment Revolving Fund for the support of the following projects:

- \$330,000 for improvements in the Colorado Street Pavement Project;
- \$105,000 for improvements in the vicinity of Stewart Street and Musser Street; and
- \$200,000 for improvements in the vicinity of Stewart Street and Telegraph Street.
