Pursuant to Article 4, Section 12 of the Nevada Constitution and NRS chapter 218A, recommendation to appoint an individual to fill the vacancy in the office of Senate District 16, comprised of portions of Washoe County and Carson City recently vacated by Benjamin Kieckhefer, for the remainder of his term to expire upon the swearing in of the successful candidate at the next regular election in 2022. The two nominees for the appointment were selected previously by the Washoe County Board of Commissioners on November 9, 2021, and the Carson City Board of Supervisors on November 4, 2021 from the following list: Melissa T. Clement, Jessica Glover, Rew Robert Goodenow, Steven Guerrazzi, Ronald W. Haslem, Lisa Krasner, Maxine Nietz, Heidi Palmer, Larry Peyton, Tracy Dawn Smith, Donald Tatro, Jeffery Thiede and Robert L. Weise. This item will be considered jointly with the Washoe County Board of County Commissioners and may include votes by both boards as well as votes by the chairs of each board in accordance with NRS 218A.260. Following the appointment, the Washoe County Board of Commissioners shall issue a certificate of appointment naming the appointee, which the Washoe County Clerk shall then give the appointee with a copy to the Nevada Secretary of State Manager's Office.

\*\*PUBLIC COMMENT LIMITATIONS. Public comments are welcomed during the Public Comment periods for all matters, whether listed on the agenda or not, and are limited to three minutes per person. Additionally, public comment of three minutes per person will be heard during individually numbered items designated as "for possible action" on the agenda. Persons are invited to submit comments in writing on the agenda items and/or attend and make comment on that item at the meeting. Persons may not allocate unused time to other speakers.

Forum Restrictions and Orderly Conduct of Business. The presiding officer may order the removal of any person whose statement or other conduct disrupts the orderly, efficient or safe conduct of the meeting. Warnings against disruptive comments or behavior may or may not be given prior to removal. The viewpoint of a speaker will not be restricted, but reasonable restrictions may be imposed upon the time, place and manner of speech. Irrelevant and unduly repetitious statements and personal attacks which antagonize or incite others are examples of speech that may be reasonably limited.

Responses to Public Comments. The Boards can deliberate or take action only if a matter has been listed on an agenda properly posted prior to the meeting. During the public comment period, speakers may address matters listed or not listed on the published agenda. The Open Meeting Law does not expressly

prohibit responses to public comments by the Boards. However, responses from the Boards to unlisted public comment topics could become deliberation on a matter without notice to the public. On the advice of legal counsel and to ensure the public has notice of all matters the Boards will consider, Board members may choose not to respond to public comments, except to correct factual inaccuracies, ask for staff action or to ask that a matter be listed on a future agenda.

Agenda Management Notice - Items on the agenda may be taken out of order; combined with other items; removed from the agenda; moved to the agenda of another meeting; moved to or from the Consent section; or may be voted on in a block. Items with a specific time designation will not be heard prior to the stated time, but may be heard later. The Consent is a single agenda item and is considered as a block and will not be read aloud. The Boards may take breaks approximately every 90 minutes.

Titles of agenda items are intended to identify specific matters. If you desire detailed information concerning any subject matter itemized within this agenda, you are encouraged to call the responsible agency or the Carson City, City Manager's Office. You are encouraged to attend this meeting and participate by commenting on any agendized item.
