Staff Summary: The County Health Rankings is a report generated annually by the University of Wisconsin Populations Health Institute since 2010. This report compiles information on nearly every county in all 50 states. Carson City's 2020 County Health Rankings are 13th out of 15 on Health Outcomes, and 9th out of 15 on Health Factors. A review of the past rankings will be included in the presentation. Given the Carson City rankings, the community should strategize on ways to improve Carson City's community health. In 2022, the third Community Health Needs Assessment ("CHNA") will be conducted. After the CHNA, a Community Health Improvement Plan ("CHIP") will be developed. HiAP can be one approach that can be incorporated in the CHIP. Improving

the health of a community is a community effort.




