## **Proposed Motion**

I move to recommend amending the Open Space Advisory Committee and Parks and Recreation Commission joint meeting schedule as presented.

### **Board's Strategic Goal**

#### **Previous Action**

November 5, 2020: The Board approved the proposed amendments to the Open Space Advisory Committee Bylaws.

August 17, 2020: The Open Space Advisory Committee made a recommendation to the Board of Supervisors to approve the proposed amendments to the Open Space Advisory Committee bylaws.

October 17, 2019: The Board approved amendments to the Parks and Recreation Commission (PRC) Bylaws.

April 19, 2018 (excerpt): The Board of Supervisors directed the Open Space Advisory Committee meet four times per year and recommended two joint meetings with the Parks and Recreation Commission.

### **Background/Issues & Analysis**

In 2018, the Board of Supervisors met to discuss a potential combination of the Parks and Recreation Commission and the Open Space Advisory Committee. Staff received significant public opposition to dissolving the Open Space Advisory Committee. However, in order to encourage communication and coordination between the two groups, an alternative was presented to implement two joint meetings per year, in addition the four individual meetings. Joint meeting topics may include natural resource management, development review, trails, community outreach/education, Park Ranger roles and responsibilities, planning,

grants, operations/maintenance, and other items that are prevalent throughout the entire Carson City park system. Members are proposing a modification to this by reducing the joint meeting requirement to once per year, or as needed.
