Staff Summary: NRS 361.340 establishes the CCBOE, consisting of 5 members. The Mayor shall nominate persons to serve on the CCBOE and the nominees must be appointed by a majority vote of the Board of Supervisors. Jill Rasner, who was previously nominated upon recommendation of Supervisor Giomi and appointed to CCBOE by the

Board of Supervisors, is unable to complete her term. Supervisor Giomi is now

recommending that the Mayor nominate Colette Burau to fill the remainder of Ms. Rasner's

four-year term, ending in January 2023.

Background/Issues & Analysis

Pursuant to NRS 361.340(4), the chair of the board of county commissioners (or, as applied to Carson City, its Mayor for the Board of Supervisors) shall nominate persons to serve on the county board of equalization who are sufficiently experienced in business generally to be able to bring knowledge and sound judgment to the deliberations of the board or who are elected public officers. The nominees must be appointed upon a majority vote of the board of county commissioners. Pursuant to NRS 361.340(5), the term of each member is 4 years, and any vacancy must be filled by appointment for the unexpired term. The term of any elected public officer expires upon the expiration of the term of his or her elected office.
