Background/Issues & Analysis

During an internal audit, it was discovered that a residential building was incorrectly added to this parcel. This resulted in an overassessment. The Assessor's Office is requesting that the taxes be adjusted to reflect the correct amount and a refund be issued for any amount paid in excess from the FY 2021/2022 Real Property Tax Roll. The correction would result in \$3,150.06 being removed and \$1,906.28 refunded to the owner. This property falls within a landscape maintenance district and the amount of the refund has been adjusted to include the remaining \$70.00 due for the current FY.
