Under Section 3, staff recommends removing the reference to physically posting in at least four (4) locations which is no longer required under Open Meeting Law.

Lastly, under Section 6, staff recommends changing Clerk-Recorder to City Manager regarding where written notification should be sent.

CARSON CITY CHARTER REVIEW COMMITTEE BYLAWS

- **1.** <u>Meetings.</u> The language of section 1.090(2) and (3) of the Carson City Charter is incorporated herein by reference. Meeting times will be designated by the committee. All meetings, whether regular or special, shall be made public. A majority of members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
- 2. <u>Special Meetings.</u> Special meetings may be called at any time by the chairperson or by any three (3) members of the committee. The purpose of the meeting shall be stated and shall be delivered to each member indicating the time, date, and place of the meeting. Non-decision making workshops may be called by the chairperson or any three (3) members of the committee.
- **3.** <u>Notice of Meetings.</u> Notices shall conform with the Nevada Open Meeting law, NRS 241. Notices of the meetings are to be posted at least three (3) working days prior to the scheduled meeting and in at least four (4) locations.
- **4.** Officers. The language of section 1.090(1) of the Carson City Charter is incorporated herein by reference. In the absence of the chairperson and vice chairperson, the quorum present shall appoint a chairperson *pro tempore* by majority vote.

The City shall provide a secretary to act as recorder, vote counter, and to take roll.

5. Duties of the Chairperson.

- a. The chairperson shall be responsible for the conduct of all committee meetings;
- b. The chairperson shall confer with City staff on the matters scheduled for the agenda;
- c. The chairperson may request that items be scheduled for a committee meeting. If other committee members wish to schedule an item, such request shall be made to the chairperson or by three members of the committee;
- d. In the absence of the chairperson, these duties shall be assumed by the vice chairperson, then the chairperson *pro tempore*.
- **6.** Resignation. Any committee member may resign at any time by sending written notification to the Carson City Clerk-Recorder, and to the public officer or elected official who recommended the member's appointment to the committee.
- 7. <u>Amendment.</u> An amendment to these bylaws introduced at any regular meeting shall be voted on at the next meeting and require an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the total committee membership in order to pass.
- **8.** <u>Attendance.</u> The language of Section 1.100 of the Carson City Charter is incorporated herein by this reference. Regular attendance at meetings shall be expected of all members. Timely contact with the chairperson or City staff is required in the event of a committee member's absence from a scheduled meeting.

9. Quorum.

- a. A quorum shall be a simple majority of the committee;
- b. To be considered an approval motion, a vote of a simple majority of the committee present shall be required.

10. Conduct of the Meetings.

- a. Committee members shall attend the meetings in appropriate attire to represent the image and authority of the committee;
- b. Committee members shall arrive in a timely manner prior to the opening gavel.

The governing ordinance requires that proposed amendments to the Charter be heard and debated by the Committee, who then advises the Board of Supervisors with regard to recommendations of the Committee that concern necessary amendments to the Charter. Public input will be solicited beginning February 24 through March 31, 2022.

Staff is aware of several recommended changes to the Charter. The first in Section 1.060 (3) discusses the creation of ward boundaries. The proposed change would remove the requirement in subsection 3 to complete realignment on or before January 1 preceding the next general election.

Additionally, there is a recommendation to clarify language in Section 3.015 regarding the Mayor Pro Tempore serving as Mayor until the next general election if the Office of Mayor becomes vacant.

These proposed changes will be brought forward for further discussion following solicitation of public input.

Carson City Charter Review Committee

Background & Process

What is a city charter?

A city charter acts as a constitution for a city. The charter can only be amended or repealed by the Nevada Legislature.

When was the City's Charter adopted?

The City's current charter dates from 1969.

What is the purpose of the Charter Review Committee?

The governing ordinance requires that proposed amendments to the Charter be heard and debated by the Committee, who then advises the Board of Supervisors with regard to recommendations of the Committee that concern necessary amendments to the Charter. Additionally, the Committee assists the Board in the timely preparation of such amendments for presentation to the Legislature on behalf of the City.

How long will the Charter Review Committee's review take?

The first meeting will be in February to elect officers, review Nevada Open Meeting Law, discuss procedure, and establish future meeting dates. The Committee will meet at least one time in April to consider community input. Additional meetings may be scheduled if it is necessary to review proposed amendments or additions. The Committee will present proposed amendments to the Board of Supervisors in a joint meeting typically scheduled in July.

What issues will the Charter Review Committee examine?

Public input for suggestions will be solicited beginning February 24th thru March 31st. This includes the distribution of a press release to appropriate media contacts and social media as well as publishing a notice in the Nevada Appeal stating the Charter Review Committee is accepting recommendations to the City's Charter. Suggestions are also collected online at the City's website - www.carson.org/crc.
