Agenda Title: For Possible Action: Discussion and possible action regarding a proposed \$90,000

increase in Fiscal Year ("FY") 2022 purchase authority, beyond the previously approved \$320,000, for the purchase of Sodium Hypochlorite (Bleach) utilizing a City of Tucson

("Tucson") joinder contract (#212528) with Thatcher Company of Arizona, Inc.

("Thatcher"), resulting in a new not to exceed amount of \$410,000 for FY 2022. (Carol

Akers, Cakers@carson.org and Andy Hummel, Ahummel@carson.org)

Staff Summary: If approved, the \$90,000 increase in purchase authority will be used to purchase important chemicals for the treatment of City wastewater. The joinder contract with Thatcher allows for semi-annual price adjustments, and inflation and severe market

disruptions have resulted in a 57% price increase over the last year.

Previous Action

On June 17, 2021, the Board of Supervisors approved FY 2022 purchase authority for the purchase of Bleach utilizing joinder contract #212528 between Tucson and Thatcher, for an annual not to exceed amount of \$320,000 (File No. 21300005).

Background/Issues & Analysis

Bleach is utilized for disinfection of treated wastewater prior to discharge to the reuse system and is a vital part of the treatment process to ensure pathogens are removed. Pathogen removal is a requirement of the City's NDEP regulatory permit. Residual levels are monitored and adjusted multiple times a day to ensure efficient use while maintaining minimum levels necessary for treatment.

Carson City purchases Bleach from Thatcher under a joinder contract which allows for price adjustments every six months to adjust for price fluctuations and inflation. Over the last two periods, the price for Bleach has risen from \$1.18/gallon to \$1.85/gallon, an increase of 57%. These unexpected price increases, as well as the importance of Bleach to the City's wastewater treatment system, have necessitated this request to increase the FY 2022 purchase authority.

Staff Summary: The Carson City Public Works and Parks and Recreation Departments are looking to utilize a joinder contract between Tucson and Thatcher to purchase Sodium Hypochlorite (12.5%) for use at the wastewater treatment plant, quill treatment plant and the aquatic center for pool disinfection. The contract between Tucson and Thatcher will expire on September 30, 2021, but Tucson has the unilateral right to renew for four,

one-year terms, subject to price renegotiation at renewal.

- -Wastewater Chemicals Account 5103201 500637 for \$270,000 currently budgeted in FY 2022 at \$261,000, small difference of \$9,000 will come from roll-forward savings in FY 2021 total wastewater budget, and will be added to FY 2022 budget.
- -Water Chemicals Account 5203502 500637 for \$40,000, currently budgeted in FY 2022 at \$124,964. (\$90,000 diatomateous earth contract plus this \$40,000 equals \$130,000) small difference of \$5,036 will come from roll-forward savings in FY 2021 total water budget, and will be added to FY 2022.
