

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-R-13**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISBURSEMENT OF COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES GRANT FUNDS TO NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS FOR FY 2023

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505(1) provides that the Board of Supervisors may grant money to private, not for profit organizations; and

WHEREAS, NRS 244.1505(3) provides that such grants must be made by a resolution which specifies the purpose of the grant, the maximum amount to be expended from the grant, and any other conditions upon the expenditure; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has approved the expenditure of funds for community support services grants, the City has received applications for those grant funds, and the Board of Supervisors has determined that the disbursement of the grants to the private, not for profit organizations that are listed below will give a substantial benefit to the inhabitants of Carson City;

NOW, THEREFORE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS RESOLVES THAT:

1. For FY 2023, the following groups are granted the following amounts for the following purposes:

4. The grant money may only be spent for the purposes listed in the resolution, which is the purpose given to Carson City by the requesting private organizations in their applications to Carson City.




