ROBERT JOHNSTON is a Senior Attorney with Western Resource Advocates, a non-profit environmental law and policy organization dedicated to protecting the West's land, air and water resources. Western Resource Advocates works in the Interior Western United States, with offices in Colorado, Utah, Arizona, Nevada and New Mexico. Before joining Western Resource Advocates in 2015, Mr. Johnston practiced law in Carson City, Nevada as a partner with Kilpatrick, Johnston & Adler, and then as a sole practitioner. His areas of specialization included public utility law, where he represented a wide variety of energy and telecommunications companies before the Nevada Public Utilities Commission in certificate applications, general rate cases, environmental permit applications, integrated resource plan proceedings and rulemakings. Since 2007, Mr. Johnston has represented Western Resource Advocates and Nevadans for Clean Affordable Reliable Energy before the Public Utilities Commission in integrated resource plan proceedings, rulemakings, investigations, and other matters concerning renewable energy and energy efficiency. Nevadans for Clean Affordable Reliable Energy is a non-profit association of public interest entities (including Western Resource Advocates) with a common interest in promoting the expanded use of renewable energy and energy efficiency, and in preserving the quality of the environment in Nevada.

Prior to entering private practice in 1984, Mr. Johnston worked for the Public Utilities Commission for six years, including four years as Staff Counsel. Mr. Johnston earned his J.D. from the University of North Carolina in 1976 and his B.A. in Political Science from the University of California in 1972.

Mr. Johnston currently serves on the board of Advocates to End Domestic Violence, the board of the Nevada Clean Energy Fund, and as a member of Carson City's Utility Finance Oversight Committee.
