Previous Action

April 20, 2023 (Item 25A): The Redevelopment Authority reviewed and made recommendations regarding the FY 2024 discretionary funds tentative budget allocations by a vote of 4-1, 0 absent.

February 6, 2023 (Item 4.B): The Redevelopment Authority Citizens Committee ("RACC") recommended approval of the various expenditures by a vote of 6-0, 1 absent.

Background/Issues & Analysis

The Redevelopment Budget includes line items that are funded at the sole discretion of the Redevelopment Authority, as well as items that are part of the discretionary allocation program for which RACC makes recommendations. The purpose of this agenda item is to make a recommendation to the Board to authorize the expenditures for various projects, programs and incentives as included in the approved FY 2024 Redevelopment Budget. Other projects and programs in the Redevelopment Budget will not be approved for expenditure until or unless specific requests are made or additional details of the projects or programs are available for review and approval. The Redevelopment Authority and Board annually approve the majority of Redevelopment expenditures in the budget year so that the funds are available for expenditure.

The proposed expenditures are for the following projects, programs and incentives in the FY 2024 Redevelopment budget:

\$50,000: arts and culture special events.

\$25,000: Nevada Day.

\$22,000: the farmers market.

\$10,000: Silver and Snowflake Christmas tree lighting.

\$15,000: Fourth of July fireworks.

\$370,800: sales tax reimbursement incentive program for the Southgate Mall and Carson Mall.

\$227,758: Richard Campagni (auto dealer) incentive.

\$285,650: Michael Hohl (auto dealer) incentive.

\$25,000: special event street closures.

\$25,000: Façade Improvement Program.

\$25,000: Downtown equipment and infrastructure replacement.

\$20,000: Sidewalk and Utility Assistance Program.

\$200,000: Sidewalk and ADA Improvements.

\$10,500: ADA Compliant Doors for the Community Center.

\$75,000: Mills Park Walkway Replacement.

\$400,000: East William Complete Streets.

\$100,000: Stewart Street Streetscape and Sidewalk.

\$75,000: Downtown Gateway Feature.

\$400,000: Engine House Arch.

\$200,000: Appion Signal Construction.

\$1,100,000: Community Center HVAC.

\$20,000: Community Center Interior Signage.

\$25,000: Downtown Trash Enclosure.

\$67,000: Fencing and a Replacement Door at the Foreman Robert's House.
