Lead and Copper Rule Revisions Service Line Inventory Background

On August 4, 2022, EPA released Guidance for Developing and Maintaining a Water Service Line Inventory to support water systems with their efforts to develop inventories and to provide states with needed information for oversight and reporting to EPA. Utilities are now required to prepare and maintain an inventory of water service lines from the main in the street to your house's stem wall by October 16, 2024.

Galvanized pipe is grey, silvery, or whitish metal, and a magnet will stick to galvanized pipe. Lead, copper, and plastic pipes are not magnetic.

Copper is similar in color and shine to a penny, may have green or blue coloration, and is non-magnetic.
