The "fully meets expectations rating" will be the same as the third established merit percentage rating set forth by Carson City for Unclassified Employees. The "does not fully meet expectations" and "unacceptable ratings" will not receive any merit increase for Unclassified Court employees.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Order and the First Judicial District Unclassified Job Performance Appraisal form shall be filed with the First Judicial District Court Clerk's Office and copies disseminated by the Clerk to the Carson City Manager's Office, Department of Human Resources, Finance Department, and District Attorney's Office.
