



REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION

The Carson City Board of Supervisors is seeking applications from persons interested in serving on the Regional Transportation Commission (RTC). The RTC is the policy making body on transportation issues within Carson City whose purpose is to establish priorities and recommend appropriate funding for transportation improvement projects. The members of the Regional Transportation Commission also serve on the Carson Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Board (CAMPO) to discuss and take action on federal monies spent on transportation and transit projects within the Carson Metropolitan Planning Area.

There is one (1) position open, for a term that expires December 2026.

The Commission meets on the second Wednesday of the month at 4:30 p.m. after the adjournment of the CAMPO meeting. Applicants should be prepared for a minimum commitment of up to ten hours a month. The position shall serve without compensation.

Applications will be accepted until November 15, 2024. Interviews for this volunteer position are *tentatively* planned to be held at the regularly scheduled Board of Supervisors meeting on Thursday, December 5, 2024.
