



Carson City Audit Committee

The Carson City Board of Supervisors is seeking applications from individuals who may be interested in serving on the Audit Committee as a **Citizen-At-Large**. There are two (2) open positions, each to fill a term that ends in **December 2026**.

Applicants must be:

- A resident of Carson City
- Have experience in financial services, public accounting, and/or governmental auditing, and current knowledge of public laws and regulations governing an audit committee.
- Shall not accept any consulting, advisory, or other compensatory fees from the city and may not be an affiliated person with the city or any subsidiary thereof.

The role of the Carson City Audit Committee is to maintain oversight of the auditing function, internal and external, resulting in increased integrity and efficiency of the audit processes for the city and the city's system of internal controls and financial reporting.

The Committee meetings are held at least quarterly. Applicants should be prepared for a minimum commitment of up to three hours a month. The positions shall serve without compensation.

Let it be known that all applications submitted to this office will be considered public information. Applications will be accepted until November 29, 2024. Interviews for this volunteer position are **tentatively** planned to be held at the regularly scheduled Board of Supervisors meeting on Thursday December 19, 2024.
