#### 1. Adjusted Modification Factors

Our actuary has recalculated and adjusted the PACT modification factors to be used effective July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. Your modification factor, based on historical payroll and losses incurred by your entity, for the next year is on the attached worksheet.

#### 2. Classifications

### 3. ACH Transfer Amount & Agent Compensation

The amounts for the ACH transfer and agent compensation for the new fiscal year will be calculated after the payroll audits for this year have been completed. We will notify you of these amounts around mid-September.

#### 4. Reminder - Police/Fire Retirees Heart Funding

Code 9999 uses the payroll total for your paid police and paid fire classifications as its rating basis. It is not subject to the experience modification factor (mod), agent fees, or any other service-related expenses.

## 5. Payroll Audits

As always, we are under strict time constraints to have the PACT annual financial audit completed and submitted to the State not later than 90 days after the end of the fiscal year. An important portion of the financial audit is the payroll audits. We anticipate that the payroll audits will be starting as early as mid-July, 2007.

The payroll auditors will be contacting you to set up an appointment and will notify you as to what records they require for the audit. Remember that the person(s) designated by you to sign off on the payroll audit results must be present for the exit interview with the auditor.

As last year, auditors will be instructed to check your volunteer rosters, which should be used as back up to your quarterly assessment worksheets.
